ISPN Foundation Nursing Research Grant: Call for Proposals

ONE GRANT SUPPORTING psychiatric nursing research is available to ISPN members involved in psychiatric-mental health nursing research for 2007. The amount of the grant is \$500.00.

Investigators

- Must be an ISPN member **and**
- Must have a Masters or a Doctorate in nursing **OR** be a student in a nursing graduate program

Focus of Research

- Qualitative or quantitative research is acceptable

Requirements

- Institutional Review Board approval must be obtained before the release of funds

Proposals, limited to 5 pages, **Must** Include

- Title and Purpose
- Background and Significance
- Hypotheses or Research Question(s) (if applicable)
- Methods (subjects/participants, setting, instruments, procedures, data analysis)
- Appendices (not included in 5-page limit)
 - Budget with justification
 - Time line
 - Status of IRB approval
 - References

Do not exceed 5 single-spaced pages. Submit 1 electronic version (Word or .pdf files) of the proposal with no identifying information on the title page. At the end of this file include a cover page with your name, address, phone number and e-mail. Also include your ISPN division. Provide the same information for all co-investigators (however, only the PI needs to be a member of ISPN). If you are a student, please include faculty advisor(s) as well.

Recipients are expected to submit

- A written summary of completed research to the ISPN Research Council
- An abstract to the ISPN Conference and be willing to present within the next 2 years
- A manuscript to one of ISPN's professional journals
- Acknowledge the support of ISPN in all presentations or publications

Deadline: received by January 1, 2007.

Notification of award will be made at the annual conference.
